LIVING SOILS COMMUNITY LEARNING FARM

The Living Soils Community Learning Farm, situated in Lynedoch, Stellenbosch is a pilot-project that was launched early 2019. Living Soils aims to demonstrate ecologically-regenerative farming practices, while providing a platform of learning to young and emerging farmers and the local community at large, for the benefit of food security of the local community.

The farm is led by four amazing young women from Kaya-mandi who learnt how to farm using ecologically-regenerative agriculture practices guided by Woolworths' Farming for the Future principles. The aim is to produce seasonal vegetables that are protective and restorative to the local ecosystem. The food that they grow helps to feed 200 children that attend school at the Sustainability Institute and households from the local Lynedoch community.

The vegetables are growing well, and we have surplus produce available that can be bought by the community at large. As far as possible we do not want to waste any food. Your purchase will help Living Soils generate income that enables us to support and train young farmers, and also ensure we continue to provide food to our children and households in Lynedoch
